

We are so excited to produce our **FIRST** of many community theater shows at North Florida School of Special Education!

Greenlight Theatre Company's mission is to engage, educate, and inspire our community through high-quality, inclusive productions, classes, and other programming for all ages and abilities.

Our production and programming at GTC instills inclusivity through reverse inclusion! What is reverse inclusion? Reverse inclusion at Greenlight Theatre Company refers to a practice where individuals with disabilities are included in theatrical productions in a way that challenges traditional norms. Instead of being segregated or excluded, individuals with disabilities are actively involved in all aspects of the production, including acting, directing, set design, and more. This approach promotes diversity, inclusivity, and the celebration of everyone's unique abilities within the theatrical community.

NO COST TO PARTICIPATE!

All auditionees should be prepared to sing a musical theatre song or selection (1 minute or less), or one of the short musical theatre selections from the show. Please see the suggested audition selections at the end of this packet for ideas of songs to sing from the show. Students should choose an audition selection and be prepared to sing acapella or with the track accompaniment.



All Conflicts must be submitted at the auditions. It is possible we can accommodate 1 or 2 conflicts during the rehearsal period, but at GTCC it is expected to attend all rehearsals that you are called for, tech days and performances listed due to the demands of the production. **Please note not everyone is called to every rehearsal until tech week.**

NOTE If you are planning to participate in another activity or production, regardless of show dates - that is a conflict, so please list it on the conflict sheet.

1. All conflicts must be handed in by Callbacks. After casting has been finalized, additional conflicts or new conflicts are considered unexcused absences, and may lead to forfeiting your role.

2. Cast members with more than three absences or unexcused absences may be released from the production.

3. Cast Members may not miss any tech days or performances. The week prior to our performances will be an intensive rehearsal and tech week; all actors will be expected to attend the daily rehearsals. Participants may have no conflicts during tech week.

CALLBACKS: At callback auditions, the casting committee may ask certain actors to sing again, read a scene or dance again. All who audition will not be called back, but that does not mean that they are not being considered for the show. Many parts are cast after the initial audition and do not require a callback. Also, if you are asked to sing or read for a specific part, this does not guarantee that you will be cast in that part or are being considered for that part.

CAST LIST: The cast lists will emailed out from our email <u>greenlighttheatreco@gmail.com</u>. Please make sure our emails do not go to SPAM.

Please do not contact GTC staff to discuss casting decisions. Final Casting is determined by the whole creative team and often a performer's talent level is not the only reason they were cast (or not cast) in a role. Casting is a complicated process and many factors are taken into consideration. The team's decisions impact the production and the entire program.



Casting Notes

• There are lots of great parts in every show. Everyone will have an opportunity to shine! Acast list determines that you are in the show, but often does not reflect exactly what your responsibilities will be in performance.

• Please try to temper your casting expectations. Discourage the expectation of being cast in a "big role". Please speak to performers in advance and help

them focus their excitement on being a part of the show, not a specific role. This will lead to a better casting experience for all involved.

WHAT ARE WE LOOKING FOR?

The Wizard of OZ i is an exciting, fun and high energy show and it needs a cast to match. We are looking for:

- Variety in look with all shapes and sizes
- Versatility in acting range, with the ability to play more than one character,

including characters of contrasting ages

- Strong solo singers who can also blend in an ensemble
- Strong singers who can dance
- Strong dancers who can sing
- Triple threats
- Friendly people who work hard
- Commitment to the show and rehearsal process
- A good attitude

GTC Drop-Out Policy: When you audition for GTC there is an expectation that you want your performer to be a part of the "show" and not just a lead role. Dropping out after the callback list or cast list is posted goes against our philosophy of teamwork that is an important part of theatre. However, for those performers who only want a certain role, we have added a line on the audition form that allows the auditionee to indicate if she/he will accept any part or only a specific role. Be Honest- Dropping out of a production after the callback or cast list is released may affect eligibility for future GTC productions.

GTC Casting Philosophy:



The casting of roles is part of the reality of putting on a theater production. Unfortunately, we have had a few incidents of parents or performers being unhappy with their parts and approaching our staff with inappropriate discussions. Please trust our casting team to make the best decision for your child and the show, and know that we understand how much this

experience means to your child. We always work to highlight everyone's individual talents in the production. Theater is about community, and in the spirit of community we believe in the principles of ensemble theatre making. Every cast member is important to the finished piece. That does not mean that every cast member will have the same number of lines or features in the show. For us, theatre is about the process of working together as a team to put on an amazing show, and the individual journey for you and your performer to be a part of something that they can be proud of.

Casting takes many things into account (age, experience, maturity, vocal range, acting ability, dance ability, schedules, cast member behavior during previous productions, etc), and each decision is difficult for our team. We do not have favorites, or cast because of the length of time a child has been with us. We always work to cast the performer with the best combination of skills that fit the role, in a role they can handle.





Young Kansas girl, earnest, expressive, and strong-willed, in search of something more. Very strong singer who moves well.


Plucky and clever in a pinch, even while lacking a brain. Strong actor with an honest quality. Excellent dancer – acrobatic skills a bonus.

Desperate for a heart. A kind-hearted romantic. Singing and dance required.

A mix of bravado and cowardice. Should move well. Cuddly actor with excellent comic timing.

Character villain with an over-the-top stage presence. Excellent comic actress, has a killer cackle. Sings comically. Will be played by a Guest Artist.

Older father figure with an eccentric flair. Basic conjuring or sleight of hand a bonus. Non-Singing. Will be played by a Guest Artist



Glinda is the Good Witch of the North. Benevolent and beloved. Strong singer.

Aunt Em is demanding, but loves her niece.

Dorothy's pleasant uncle.

Strong comic actor, big presence.

The little people of Munchkinland. Long oppressed, and happy to be freed. Group singing and coordinated movement required. Dance experience a plus. There are some featured roles among the munchkins, such as The Coroner, The Lollipop Guild, and The Lullaby League.

The older chorus of the show, with featured speaking/vocal/dancing roles available. Singing and movement required.
