SIX: TEEN EDITION is a full-length adaptation of Toby Marlow and Lucy Moss' international phenomenon SIX, modified for performance by teen actors for family audiences.

Divorced, beheaded, died, divorced, beheaded, survived. From Tudor Queens to Pop Icons, the SIX wives of Henry VIII take the mic to remix five hundred years of historical heartbreak into a Euphoric Celebration of 21st-century girl power! This new original musical is the global sensation that everyone is losing their head over.

MANDATORY PARENT MEETING

We will have a mandatory parent meeting on the first day from 10-10:30 AM. Please make arrangements to attend. Even if your student has participated in a GTC production previously, you must attend.





Please note that this is a tuition based production camp. If you have not completed payment or selected a payment plan, your child will not participate in the final performances.

AUDITIONS/CASTING

Auditions will take place the first day of camp. Below is our SIX Audition Form. Please print it out and bring it with you on the first day.

Please note the original production calls for 6 characters. We are making this an ensemble show and putting each person into a Queen's House (House of Jane Seymour, House of Anne Boylen, House of Catherine of Aragon...etc.). This creates more solo opportunities, cooler harmonies within the numbers, dance featured parts, and the opportunity to work in an ensemble. Each student will receive a solo.

WHAT TO PREPARE

Prepare a 1-minute monologue and 32 bars of a song in the style of the show OR a song from the show. Please have an accompaniment track.. The song will need to be memorized. Headshot and resume are not necessary, but if you would like to bring one, please do. Auditions will take place the first day of camp.

Casting decisions are made solely by the Creative Team. As performers we know that auditions and cast lists can be disappointing. We ask you, as an adult, to be upbeat and positive with your reactions. As former dramatic children, we encourage the tears and big feelings. Feel the disappointment, but then move on and join the group to make magic. Theater is only successful with a cohesive, united group. Regardless of the size of the role, each and every performer is important and will be celebrated!

REHEARSALS

Our rehearsals are from 10AM-4PM, Monday-Friday. There will be very little down time, but we have **TWO** weeks to create a magical production! We will provide you with all of the information during rehearsals - blocking, choreography...etc. Your homework outside of the rehearsal room is to practice and memorize what we work on that day.





Theatre is a big commitment of time and energy. When making the decision to participate in our program please be mindful of our schedule and the importance of rehearsals. Attendance at ALL technical (tech) week rehearsals as well as ALL performances is mandatory.

BE ON TIME!! In the theater, there is a saying, "If you arrive on-time you are late!" Be early, allow 10-15 minutes before the start of rehearsals.

Please note that unexcused absences may result in the forfeiture of your child's role.

LUNCH/SNACKS

Bring a sealed water bottle and a snack. We will have water on hand. Students **may not** leave the theater. **Please refrain from bringing any items that contain tree nuts due to** allergies.

CLOTHING

Wear clothing that makes you feel comfortable. We will be moving and dancing throughout rehearsals. Wear closed-toe shoes at all times! Absolutely no sandals, flip flops, or Crocs!

GUESTS

In order to provide a safe environment, guests are not permitted to stay in the theater during the camp day.

PERFORMANCES

Our performances will take place June 28-30th - Friday & Saturday Evening at 7PM; Saturday & Sunday Matinee at 1PM. **Performers are called 1 hour before show time.**

GTC will provide costume pieces unless otherwise specified. You are responsible for undergarments and shoes(dance shoes, jazz shoes, tennis shoes, tights, leotards, biker shorts, socks..etc.) and shoes.
