#### **AUDITION INFORMATION:**

- Prepare 16-32 bars from a musical (no longer than one minute) via smartphone accompaniment in the appropriate key. Please, no background vocals. Acapella singing is okay. We WILL NOT have a piano accompanist. Sing any song of your choice that best represents your talent and vocal range (a song from the show is fine).
- Bring a list of your conflicts with you. It's important for the us to know what
  your schedule is to make sure you are available for rehearsals. Please list all
  conflicts on BOTH scheduled below. Please note we will not accept any
  conflicts after the show is cast. Please note conflicts will have an effect on casting.
  - Casting decisions are made solely by the Creative Team. As performers we
    know that auditions and cast lists can be disappointing. We ask you, as an
    adult, to be upbeat and positive with your reactions. As former dramatic
    children, we encourage the tears and big feelings. Feel the disappointment,
    but then move on and join the group to make magic.

**SCHOOLHOUSE ROCK LIVE JR.** is an exciting, fun and high energy show and it needs a cast to match. We are looking for:

- Variety in look with all shapes and sizes
- Versatility in acting range, with the ability to play more than one character, including characters of contrasting ages
  - Strong solo singers who can also blend in an ensemble
    - Strong singers who can dance
    - Strong dancers who can sing
      - Triple threats
    - Friendly people who work hard
    - Commitment to the show and rehearsal process
      - A good attitude

#### **REHEARSALS/PERFORMANCES**

Theatre is a big commitment of time and energy. When making the decision to participate in our program please be mindful of our schedule and the importance of rehearsals. Attendance at ALL technical (tech) week rehearsals as well as ALL performances are mandatory.

BE ON TIME!! In the theater, there is a saying, "If you arrive on-time you are late!" Be early, allow 10-15 minutes before the start of rehearsals. Our doors will be open 15 minutes before rehearsal. Please do not drop off earlier.

Rehearsals will be held Mondays & Wednesdays from 3-5PM. Please see the attached rehearsal calendar.

Performances will be June 5-8, 2025. Performers are called one hour before Performances.

Tech week rehearsals will be the week leading up to the show (Monday-Wednesday) and performances are <u>MANDATORY</u> for all cast members.





#### **AUDITIONS/CASTING**

Please note that unexcused absences may result in the forfeiture of your child's role.

#### **ABOUT THE SHOW**

Schoolhouse Rock Live! follows Tom, a nerve-wracked school teacher who is nervous about his first day of teaching. He tries to relax by watching TV, when various characters representing facets of his personality emerge from the set and show him how to win his students over with imagination and music, through such songs as "Just a Bill," "Lolly, Lolly, Lolly" and "Conjunction Junction."

#### **ROLES**

These are the character names as listed in the script. **Our production will have flexible casting** and may use the actor's real name for their character instead if those listed in the script.

All of the listed characters can be renamed and cast as any actor.





Besides the following listed roles, there will be a large ensemble with many small character roles as needed in the songs. **This will be an ensemble production!** Everyone in the chorus will be featured in some way.

**Tom** is the idealistic young teacher. Tom needs to be an amiable, likable, charming performer. Tom doesn't sing much solo stuff, but needs to be a very strong and dynamic actor.

Vocal range top: D5 bottom: Bb3

**Dori** is the silly, goofy side of Tom. She needs to be a strong singer who can lead the entire ensemble. She takes the lead on "A Noun is a Person, Place or Thing", and "The Preamble". Vocal range top: C5 bottom: G4

**George** is the caring and in control part of Tom. He should be a good singer and a great character actor. George takes the lead on, "Three Is a Magic Number", and "Just a Bill."

Vocal range top: D5 bottom: Bb3

**Shulie** is Tom's sweet, genuine side. Shulie should be a strong singer and a likable character actor. Shulie takes the lead on "Unpack your adjectives", and "Interplanet Janet".

Vocal range top: G5 bottom: G4

**Dina** is Tom's mature side. She is thoughtful and grounded. Dina takes the lead on "Interjections". Dina should be a good, strong singer with an ability to sing harmony.

Vocal range top: E5 bottom: A3

**Joe** is the cool side of Tom. He's laid back and fun loving. Joe needs to deliver, "Conjunction Junction" with the right growl.

Vocal range top: F5 bottom: Bb3

**Ensemble**-the ensemble will be assigned featured parts in the songs as well as singing, dancing and acting in all chorus numbers. Featured parts include the family of three, football players, a scary bear, Lady Liberty, citizens, senators and congress members, immigrants, settlers, explorers and space travelers, Reginald, the doctor, Geraldine, Geraldo and Schoolhouse Rocky!
